







The text typed onto the alternate pages of the two preceding books is the earliest known fragment of Greek philosophy—it is attributed to the (so-called) pre-Socratic philosopher Anaximander (c. 610–546 BC) and reads:

They give justice and reparation to one another for their injustice in accordance with the arrangement of time.

This quotation refers to cosmology—suggesting that the cosmos operates in a kind of universal harmony or balance.
